



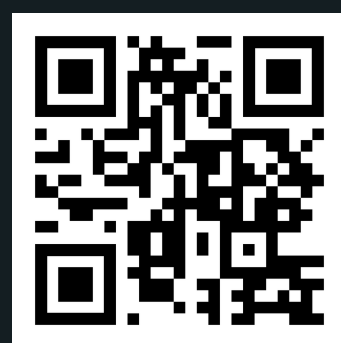

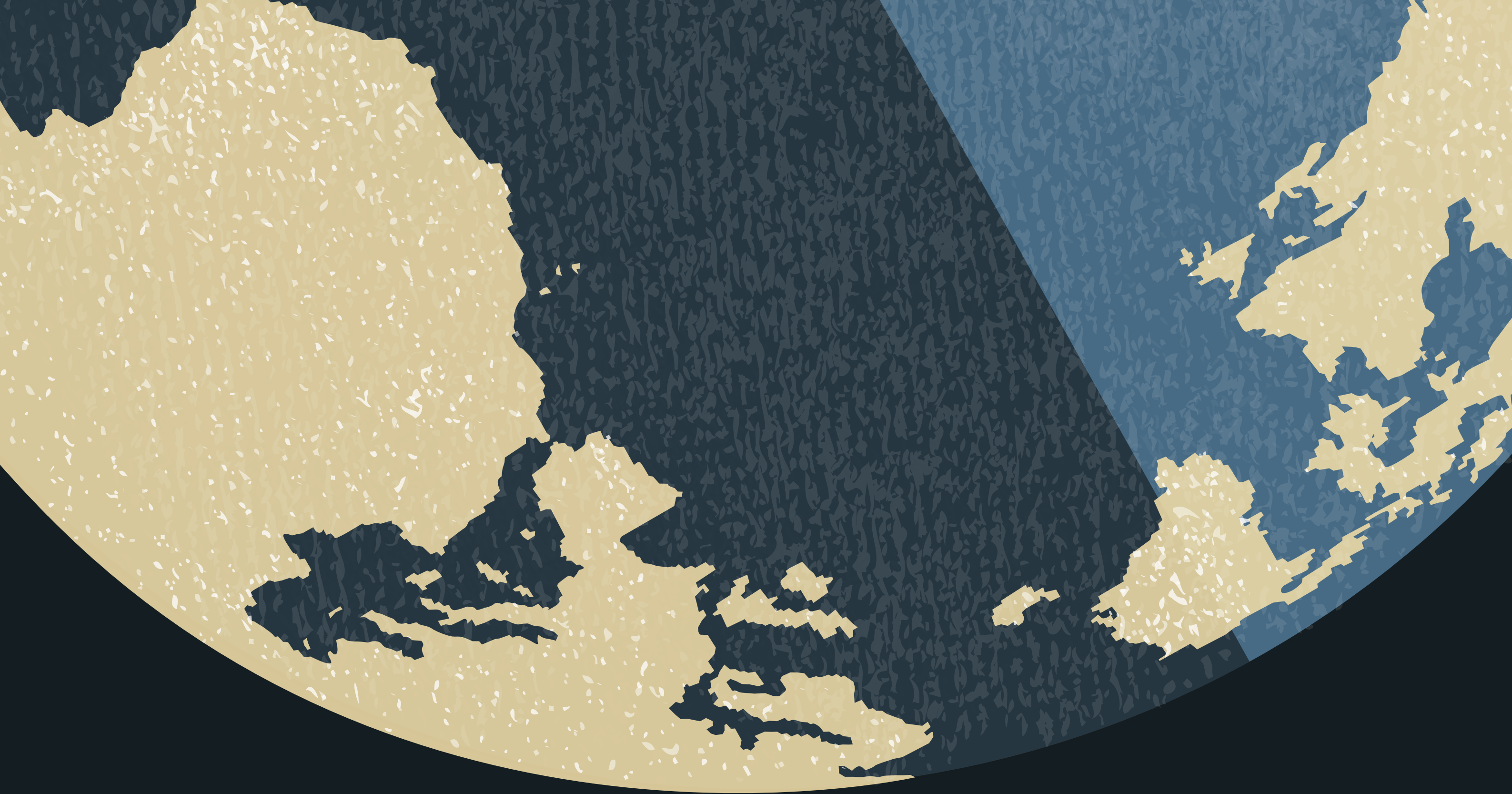

SCIENCE DIPLOMACY IN TIMES OF WAR

How should scientific institutions react to the war in Ukraine? Isolate Russia and exclude it from all scientific collaborations or “do business” as usual? The academic world is divided on this.

In a roundtable organized by Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg, historians and philosophers of science and technology together with key science administrators and academics will analyze the role of science diplomacy in times of war, historically and today.

The event will be held in English, in cooperation with the EU-funded project InsSciDE- Inventing a Shared Science Diplomacy for Europe and the ERC Consolidator Grant research project HRP-IAEA.
