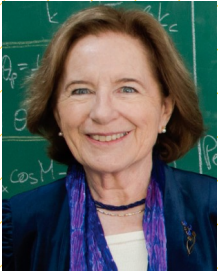

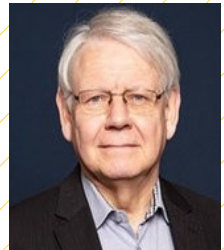

In this high-level roundtable discussion, leading experts and practitioners in science and technology diplomacy as well as in peace and security studies share their experience and knowledge with students from all over the world.



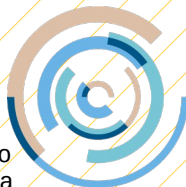
